 regulatory requirements and industry best practices. Work with BG HSEQ Business Delivery Teams to
 ensure BG operational/process safety and risk management are aligned with local legislation, international
 standards, corporate HSEQ requirements, and industry best practices, as well as regularly review and
 update risk registers, operational and process safety procedures, and safety rule book.
- Develop and manage corporate HSEQ legal register and risk register. Review and integrate risk assessments
 of BGs, manage critical/high risks and recommend risk/loss control strategies based on industry best
 practices. Regularly review BG risk management trends to proactively highlight risk exposures and work
 with BG HSEQ Business Delivery Teams to recommend practical control measures.
- Perform regular review of CLPP corporate and BG risk assessments, process hazard analysis, quantitative
 risk assessments and incident reports and recommend actions to drive continuous improvement of the
 risk management processes, systems, and critical controls.
- Work with BG HSEQ Business Delivery Teams on implementing safety audit programs. Evaluate the
 effectiveness and health of critical controls and safety measures, determine any gap and shortfall and
 provide advice for rectification and continuous improvement.
- Implement and provide support to BGs on operational and process safety management requirements, policies and standards for contractor selection and contractor management. Provide advisory support on risk management, operational and process safety observations and audits of contractors.
- Track and manage safety performance against defined KPIs and identify emerging trends and non-

conformances and recommend short- and long-term strategic plan for performance improvement. Collaborate with Safety, Quality & Management Systems team to identify, recommend, and implement methods of improving effectiveness and efficiencies of measuring and managing risk performance data.

- Coordinate and analyse data, and share lessons learnt from observation and incident reports for continuous improvement and enhancement of HSEQ management systems, processes, and procedures. Work with BG HSEQ Business Delivery Teams for timely close-out of corrective and preventive actions.
- Regularly review and update the crisis and emergency management and response plan taking into account any changes within the organisation, operating environments, and external conditions.

- Solid experience with managing risk registers and performing qualitative and quantitative risk assessments (e.g. Job Hazard Analysis, Bowtie Diagrams and Barrier Effectiveness Assessment, Quantitative Risk Assessment, etc.).
- Demonstrated experience with operational safety audits, incident investigation techniques (e.g. Taproot, ICAM, Learning Teams, etc.) and developing and managing crisis and emergency management response.
