We are looking for an energetic and innovative engineering professional to join the Generation Engineering Department of our Generation Business Group. Reporting to the Outage Manager of the Project Management Branch, the appointee will be responsible for coordinating a multi-disciplinary work team (CLP project responsible officers and contractors) in order to provide high quality in outage scheduling, planning, engineering and project services to our generation business. Major Duties include:

- Ensure company's rules, instructions, guidelines and code of practices on Safety, Health, Environment and Quality are followed at sites during outage execution and be accountable for the assigned work sites;
- Assist Outage Planner to prepare outage scheduling, planning, monitor capital, operating and manpower expenses to meet performance targets;
- Participate in the liaison with the manufacturers, contractors, and internal stakeholders to ensure plant design, installation, commissioning and maintenance requirements meet the company business needs and statutory requirements;
- Coordinate a multi-disciplinary workforce to develop and implement engineering practices and to deliver reliable quality services to our generation plants to ensure that optimum level of reliability, efficiency, cost effectiveness is met;
- Liaise and communicate with relevant stakeholders during outage execution on daily basis; help resolving emerging issues with the responsible parties;
- Lead the weekly reporting during the outage execution stage;
- Coordinate and prepare report after completion of outages;
- Recommend changes in maintenance work processes with best practices and innovative ideas for continuous improvement.

Requirements:

- Higher Diploma / Higher Certificate in Mechanical / Electrical / Electronic Engineering plus 5 years' relevant experience; OR
- Ordinary Certificate in Mechanical / Electrical / Electronic Engineering plus 8 years' relevant experience. Candidates possess lesser academic qualification but with extensive relevant working experience will also be considered;

- Solid experience in engineering, maintenance, commissioning or installation of heavy mechanical equipment or facilities;
- Past exposures in contractor management will be an advantage;
- Familiar with Safety, Health and Environment related regulations and ordinances and possess good safety awareness;
- A good team player with strong analytical skill and self-initiative;
- Flexible, self-driven, and adaptable to changes and willing to meet challenges;
- Good supervisory, interpersonal, influencing and communication skills.

The appointee will be required to work in the Power Stations located at Tuen Mun area.
