The appointee will be responsible for contributing to efforts to ensure that renewable energy and battery projects are developed effectively, efficiently and responsibly. The appointee will also provide support to the regional development teams, provide ongoing development of best practices through centres of excellence and build CLP's renewable energy capabilities.

The Position profile:

- Responsible for coordinating multi-disciplinary teams through due diligence of greenfield and M&A development opportunities proposed by the regions and subsequent preparation of the investment memo for the Investment Committee on behalf of the COO.
- Provision of support, guidance and transfer of RE project development skills and knowledge to regional project development teams.
- Contribute to risk assessment and mitigation exercises.
- Managing / leading projects in centres of excellence.
- Providing input to strategic and tactical initiatives in the Renewable Energy team and the wider group.
- Analysis of technologies with the potential to contribute to CLP's progress in the energy transition.
- Attendance at relevant conferences to understand technical, commercial and market developments that could improve CLP's competitiveness / market offering.
- Regular engagement with regional BUs to maintain a project database, including the opportunity pipeline, and communicate same with senior management.

Requirements:

- A recognised university degree in engineering, mathematics, physics or related discipline. Professional Engineer, Chartered Engineer or equivalent is preferable.
- A minimum of 6 years' experience in a power systems role from a relevant background e.g. engineering, procurement, contract negotiations, finance. Understanding of how renewable energy projects transition from development through construction and operations beneficial.
- Ability to coordinate teams in a dynamic, multi-cultural, matrix organisation. Strong communication skills are required together with ability (a) to work with people from different cultures and (b) to influence outcomes. Experience of undertaking international business preferred.
- Given the international focus of the work, willingness to travel as and when required.
- Ability to deliver high quality reports within short timeframes.
- Able to communicate and engage with senior management.
- Familiarity with basic commerce / accounting / finance / legal will be beneficial.
- Strong communication skills in both spoken and written English. Ability in both spoken and written Chinese (Putonghua and simplified Chinese) is highly preferable.
