- Assist in preparing feasibility study, budget, design, and engineering of transmission improvement / renovation projects in accordance with statutory, safety, technical, cost, quality, and customer requirements
- Assist in application and monitoring of statutory permits and liaising with external parties
- Assist in planning, monitoring, and controlling project activities and implementing control procedures and practices in accordance with the Company's management systems of health, safety, security, environment, and quality (HSSEQ)
