- Carry out pre-commissioning checks and commissioning tests on equipment up to 400kV where specialist skills are required
- Manage commissioning apparatus and act as independent checker of commissioned circuits / plant equipment handover amongst departments/ branches
- Assist in providing technical advices on design and engineering of transmission plant and auxiliary equipment
- Carry out site supervision to ensure compliance with CLP Power Safety Rules, Company specifications, practices, and procedures, and to meet the work programmes
- Monitor site safety, work quality and work progress of Company's work teams and/or contractors
- Ensure that safety standards and good housekeeping practices are maintained at all times
- Perform standby duty after normal office hours, during adverse weather condition and typhoon period, and carry out driving duty, emergency repairs / shift works as and when required
- Liaise with suppliers / contractors in contract administration, vetting variation, site work measurement, conducting payment acceptance, negotiating, and resolving claims and disputes
- Monitor the site safety, work quality and work progress of Company's work teams and/or contractors
