## Public Alert Over Fake CLP Recruitment Advertisement

CLP Holdings Limited says it has reported to police authorities in both Hong Kong and Chinese mainland that a fake recruitment notice passed off as CLP's has been found on the Mainland. The Company is now taking action to address this unauthorised activity.

The company has received enquiries about job opportunities advertised through emails which claim that the company has a large number of job openings on the Mainland.

Some job seekers have told the company that they were approached by an unknown recruitment agent after sending CVs to various recruitment websites.

This recruitment agent identified themselves as (中電控股有限公司人力資源中心), a CLP operation based in Meizhou, Guangdong (廣東省梅州市).

CLP takes this opportunity to stress that:

- 1. There is no CLP operation with the name claimed by the recruitment agent;
- 2. The agent that places the job advertisements does not belong to CLP nor has CLP authorised such recruitment activity or advertisement;
- 3. CLP has no plans to recruit people for its business in the Mainland in the manner claimed.

In addition to CLP reporting this case to the police authorities, CLP reserves its right to take legal action in respect of activities undertaken by individuals or parties that infringe CLP's identity and/or intellectual property and/or misrepresent CLP's business or damage its reputation.
