# Groundbreaking CLP Power Your Love Programme achieves Record-Breaking Results

A pioneering initiative by CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) called *Power Your Love* has achieved a record-breaking result by saving energy equivalent to the annual electricity consumption of more than 2,000 households. The programme – the first in the world to combine energy saving with a mission to help the less fortunate in society – was participated by over 200,000 customers who between them saved 9.5 million kWh of electricity, the highest amount saved in any energy saving initiative by CLP Power.

In return for the energy saved, CLP Power will donate HK\$6 million from a shareholders' fund, together with some HK\$60,000 of public donation by the end of this month to subsidise the electricity bills of those in need in the society, including single and couple elderly, the severely disabled, families living in sub-divided flats and the families of boarders in special schools.

At the award presentation ceremony, CLP Power Managing Director Mr Paul Poon said, "It is encouraging to see how the *Power Your Love* programme attracted such great support from the public, our business customers and our community partners. It shows how combining energy saving with a good cause can help enhance people's awareness on the importance of energy saving and motivate them to take action to save energy."

In recognition of residential customers' contributions and businesses' efforts to get employees to support the programme, CLP Power awarded individual and corporate organisation awards to the participants who saved the most energy, achieved highest donation and referred the highest number of participants, and the organisations with the highest levels of employee participation. Mr Wong Kin Wa, a residential customer who wins the Top Energy Saving Award for the individual sector with concerted efforts from the whole family, said, "The *Power Your Love* programme encouraged us to change our daily consumption behaviour, such as combine the use of fan together with air conditioner to maximise the cooling effect and turn off any unused appliances, to save energy. These meaningful actions not only are beneficial to the environment, but also help those in need in the society."

Hong Yip Service Company Limited, one of the winners of the Super Energy Saving Award, has actively encouraged its residents and employees to participate the *Power Your Love* programme. "We have put up posters, set up promotional booth and provided on-site registration for residents at the estates, shopping malls and club houses under our management. We also distributed leaflets and sent internal broadcast to our staff to solicit their participation." Hong Yip Holdings Limited Director Ms Cimmy Yuen said.

After the success of the initiative, CLP Power has decided to run the *Power Your Love* programme again in 2016 to help make Hong Kong a greener city and to further benefit people in need.
