CLP Power Elderly Yum Cha Programme Returns in May

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) will serve up tens of thousands of free dim sum breakfasts to the elderly in a return of its popular Elderly Yum Cha community initiative. Working with four major catering associations and members of 14 District Councils in Kowloon, the New Territories and outlying islands, the programme will provide 80,000 breakfast coupons for 40,000 senior citizens to enjoy free breakfasts and expand their social networks.

Senior citizens aged 65 and above can register with participating District Council members and CLP Power will review and confirm their eligibility, with priority going to single elderly people and elderly couples. Each registered senior citizen will receive two breakfast coupons. By using their senior citizen cards and the coupons, recipients can enjoy two dim sum options with the tea charge and 10 per cent service charge waived on weekday mornings at more than 170 participating restaurants between 3 May and 30 June 2016. A HK\$2 million fund provided by CLP shareholders has been set aside to fund the programme. Details about the participating restaurants will be announced at a later date.

CLP Power Managing Director Mr Paul Poon said: "Hong Kong has an expanding elderly population, and more and more senior citizens need the care and support of the community. CLP is committed to serving the elderly through a range of community programmes. The Elderly Yum Cha programme was extremely successful last year and we are running it again to extend more warmth to elderly people and help build a more inclusive society."

The programme is supported by four major catering associations: the Association of Restaurant Managers, The Association for Hong Kong Catering Services Management Limited, the Hong Kong Federation of Restaurants & Related Trades and the Institution of Dining Art, along with more than 360 members of 14 District Councils in Kowloon, the New Territories and outlying islands. Mr Poon said CLP Power deeply appreciated the dedicated support and coordination of programme partners and participating restaurants in making the service possible. In its launch year in 2015, the Elderly Yum Cha community programme benefited 30,000 elderly people.
