CLP Power Extends Free Electric Vehicle Charging and Upgrades CLP App and Website to Provide Latest Data

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited ("CLP Power") supports green motoring and provides a city-wide electric vehicle (EV) charging service to the public. The company today (28 November) announced it will extend the free charging service at its network of EV charging stations until the end of 2018. In addition, a new feature has been added to CLP App and website, allowing the public to check the latest status of CLP Power's charging stations and locate the nearest vacant charging point.

In response to growing demand, CLP Power has recently introduced a new multistandard EV quick charger at the Tin Shing Court car park in Tin Shui Wai to encourage low carbon driving. The new charger supports most existing models of EVs in Hong Kong and will be available to the public from 30 November. CLP Power's EV charging network will then be expanded to 48 charging stations, providing 151 charging points in Kowloon, the New Territories and Lantau. CLP Power expects to complete an upgrade of all its standard chargers to semi-quick standard by the end of the year so that EV motorists can enjoy an improved, faster charging service.

The new feature on the CLP App and website give users the latest usage information about CLP Power's charging stations. EV drivers can locate vacant charging point with detailed maps and suggested driving routes. The usage information about CLP Power's charging stations is updated every 5-10 minutes. The updated information is also available on the CLP Power website.
