CLP Power will build new substations and power supply facilities and supply highly reliable and safe electricity for the airport's Three-runway System. Working with the

AA, CLP Power will provide the latest energy saving tools and information to help build a greener and smarter international airport for Hong Kong.

We will provide the electricity needed for the third runway and related infrastructure, and support Hong Kong's socio-economic development to maintain the city's status as an international business hub."
