CLP Power Distributes Nutritious Food Packages to Boost Health of Underprivileged Children and Promote Energy Savings

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) launches a **Nutritious Food Packages for Underprivileged Children Programme** to provide healthy food to more than 20,000 children, showing care for children in need under the COVID pandemic. The programme also collaborated with vocational rehabilitation centres of **St. James' Settlement** and the **Tung Wah Group of Hospitals** to put the food packages together, creating job opportunities for people with disabilities.

To promote to children the importance of decarbonisation and energy saving, each package also includes a Power Kid 3D colouring sheet, colouring pencils and a *Low-Carbon Living* story book. CLP volunteers helped distribute the food packages to children, and held STEM workshops to teach them about clean energy and energy conservation.

CLP Power is teaming up with 29 non-governmental organisations and community partners to distribute the food packages between now and August to eligible children, including tenants of subdivided units in CLP's supply areas. Based on recommendations from nutritionists, the packages include dairy drinks, cereals, healthy snacks and pasta.

CLP Power Chief Corporate Development Officer Ms Quince Chong said, "The pandemic has had a severe impact on all sectors of our society. That is why we launched a series of initiatives through the CLP Community Energy Saving Fund to provide support to people in need. The **Nutritious Food Packages for Underprivileged Children Programme** is one of these initiatives, showing care for the health and wellbeing of children and helping them adopt a low-carbon lifestyle."

Mrs Leung, parent of a beneficiary from the programme, said, "I would like to thank CLP Power for its thoughtfulness. The food package is rich in contents which have been carefully chosen and remind us the importance of giving our children healthy, balanced diets. The story book and colouring sheet included in the package also got my child interested in decarbonisation and energy saving."
