CLP Power Stages First Artwork Exhibition on Distribution Box Beautification Project Encourage the Public to Adopt Green Lifestyle

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) invited students and young artists to beautify distribution boxes. The designs integrate art and community development, aiming to promote green lifestyles and brighten up neighbourhoods. To showcase the beautified distribution boxes, an artwork exhibition is being staged from 29 September to 2 October at the B1 Atrium in Mira Place 1, Tsim Sha Tsui. The exhibition is free of charge. Members of the public are welcome to visit the exhibition during the National Day holiday this weekend.

The CLP Distribution Box Beautification Project has the theme 'Together We Power Up the Community' and aims to connect people through art and innovation and inspire them to work together towards a greener and more sustainable future. It was launched in 2021 in Hung Hom, Sham Shui Po, Tsuen Wan, and Tuen Mun and has now been extended to the other 10 districts in the CLP Power's supply area. This project is an endorsed programme of the HKSAR 25th anniversary celebration.

CLP Power this year partnered with the **Technological and Higher Education Institute of Hong Kong (THEi)** under the Vocational Training Council to invite design students and local artists to bring a splash of contemporary colour to selected distribution boxes. The designs featuring district landmarks, cultural highlights and green elements reflect the project's theme through the creativity and perspectives of young people and add vibrancy to the community. The exhibition includes a CLP Photo Studio booth where visitors can create their own WhatsApp stickers with their favourite distribution box design.

CLP Power Managing Director Mr T K Chiang said: "CLP Power has served Hong Kong for more than 120 years and is committed to sustainable development and promoting public education about energy and conservation. This project encourages young people to explore their communities and use their creativity to produce distribution box designs that capture the rich local culture. It also enhances their understanding of energy and conservation and encourages them to embrace low-carbon lifestyles. Members of the public are welcome to visit the exhibition to appreciate the artwork designs created by young people."

Following on from the exhibition, CLP Power will launch a Community Power Journey in Tsim Sha Tsui, Sham Shui Po, Yuen Long and Tung Chung from October onwards. Schools and community groups can join the guided tour and learn about the history, culture and landmarks, as well as energy saving and the relationship between electricity and communities. People can also learn about low carbon living and energy saving through an interactive game on Instagram by scanning the QR code on the sides of distribution boxes. Fact Sheet: CLP Distribution Box Beautification Project

A. Project Objectives

- With the theme 'Together We Power Up Our Community', CLP Distribution Box Beautification Project aims to inspire the community through art and innovation for a greener and sustainable future.
- This project is an endorsed programme of the HKSAR 25th anniversary celebration.

B. Project Scope

- This project covers the 14 districts of CLP Power's supply area in Kowloon, the New Territories, and outlying islands.
- This project was launched in Hung Hom, Sham Shui Po, Tsuen Wan, and Tuen Mun in 2021 and extended to the other 10 districts of CLP Power's supply area in 2022.

C. Design and Concept

- This year, CLP Power partnered with more than 30 design students from the Technological and Higher Education Institute of Hong Kong (THEi) under the Vocational Training Council to beautify selected distribution boxes in 10 districts.
- The designs were developed along the theme 'Together We Power Up Our Community'. Students were teamed up to conduct extensive community research and create unique art pieces from their perspectives by blending local landmarks and green elements. Their artworks also inject a splash of colour and vibrancy to the community.
- The artworks were then selected by a panel of judges comprising management of CLP Power and Vocational Training Council. Each awarded team received a scholarship of HK\$10,000.

D. Diversity of Activities

The following activities are organised for the public:

(1) Artwork Exhibition

An artwork exhibition will be held to showcase the beautified distribution boxes to members of the public:

o Dates: 29 September to 2 October

Opening hours: 11:00am - 10:00pm

Location: B1 Atrium, Mira Place 1, Tsim Sha Tsui

Admission: Free

(2) Instagram Filters Combining Art and Technology

• The Project combines art and technology through an immersive gaming experience on Instagram. Members of the public can scan a QR code on

the sides of the distribution boxes to enjoy an interactive experience and learn about decarbonisation and energy saving.

(3) Community Power Journey

- Guided tours for schools and community groups will be held in Tsim Sha
 Tsui, Sham Shui Po, Yuen Long and Tung Chung from October 2022 until
 March 2023. Besides visiting the distribution boxes and district landmarks,
 participants will have the opportunity to visit shops to taste their
 idiosyncratic foods and learn about the local culture and history by chatting
 with owners and employees, as well as discovering more about the
 relationship between electricity and the development of Hong Kong
 community.
- In partnership with the MTR Corporation Limited, the Community Power Journey in Tung Chung will invite business and community leaders to act as tour guides and share stories about the community's history, culture, arts, and ecological conservation, in addition to a tour to the beautified distribution box.

(4) Map of the Beautified Distribution Boxes

An online <u>map</u> lists the locations of the beautified distribution boxes in detail and encourages people to tour around the city and find out more about electricity and energy conservation, as well as the distinct culture and history of each district.
