CLP Power Wins Hong Kong Volunteer Award 2022 for its Dedication to Caring for the Community

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) has been presented the Outstanding Corporate Award in the Hong Kong Volunteer Award 2022 at a ceremony co-organised by the Home and Youth Affairs Bureau and the Agency for Volunteer Service in recognition of its outstanding performance in caring for the community through a wide range of volunteer services.

CLP Power has been at the heart of Hong Kong community for more than 120 years and is dedicated to helping people in need through its community programmes. The CLP Volunteer Team was established by a group of dedicated frontline employees in 1994 and is passionate about supporting beneficiaries, including elderly people, dementia patients, people with physical challenges, teenagers and low-income families. With more than 1,800 members, the CLP Volunteer Team is one of the largest corporate volunteer teams in Hong Kong and contributed over 11,600 hours of service to help disadvantaged people in 2021.

CLP Power Managing Director Mr T K Chiang said, "CLP Power has always been committed to caring for the community and addressing social needs. I deeply appreciate our colleagues taking part in volunteer services in their free time and using their expertise to serve the underprivileged. It is an honour for us to receive this recognition of our efforts in community work. The CLP Volunteer Team will continue to serve as a bridge between CLP Power and the community and reach out to people in need with love and care."

The CLP Volunteer Team works in partnership with community partners and nongovernmental organisations to serve the community, drawing on its expertise in the power industry. The team conducts home electrical installation inspections and shares electricity safety and energy-saving tips with elderly people. During the pandemic, members adjusted their service approach and launched a series of tailored initiatives, including caring visits to elderly people and the distribution of anti-pandemic supplies and second-hand laptops to low-income families. They also run regular initiatives such as CLP Power Connect, Hotmeal Canteen, Sharing the Festive Joy, and Be Dementia Friendly programmes. To encourage more employees to take part in volunteer services, CLP Power has set up a reward mechanism to recognise outstanding participants. The company has also supported a Voluntary Services Matching Donation Programme by giving donations to the Community Chest of Hong Kong to match the number of annual voluntary service hours that staff contributed.

Hong Kong Volunteer Award is a territory-wide scheme co-organised by the Home and Youth Affairs Bureau and the Agency for Volunteer Service that recognises the contributions and achievements of outstanding volunteers, corporations, organisations from different sectors, and cross-sectoral partnership projects. It also aims to motivate more people, particularly young people, to take part in volunteer work. The Outstanding Corporate & Non-Commercial Organisation award recognises an outstanding business corporation for its distinguished accomplishments in encouraging and supporting employees who participate in volunteer services and improving social awareness and recognition of corporate volunteers.
