CLP Stages Drama about Energy Saving and Decarbonisation to Share Christmas Joy with Low-Income Families

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) has teamed up with the Hong Kong Repertory Theatre for a Christmas show to share festive joy with around 5,000 children and parents from low-income families and promote to them decarbonisation, energy saving and electrical safety. A total of six performances of the **Community Energy Saving Fund Educational Theatre**, *Energy Heroes*, are staged between 23 and 25 December at the Grand Theatre in the Xiqu Centre in West Kowloon Cultural District. Invitations have been extended to low-income families in all 14 districts of the CLP Power supply area in the support of District Fire Safety Committees.

CLP Power Managing Director Mr T K Chiang, Council for Sustainable Development Chairman Dr Lam Ching-choi, and Hong Kong Repertory Theatre Council Chairman Mr Siu Chor-kee officiated at the opening ceremony of the first performance on 23 December. Mr Chiang said, "CLP Power fully supports the Government's goal of achieving carbon neutrality for Hong Kong before 2050. We take a holistic approach to the decarbonisation of our operations, and are committed to promoting green lifestyles and low-carbon living to young people in novel and fun ways like the **Energy Heroes** show."

Energy Heroes is a drama on the topical theme of the metaverse, teaching young audiences the importance of reducing carbon emissions and taking action to protect the environment. More than 10 youngsters took part in the production, including Angus Chow and Cornelius Sadiq who participated in CLP Power's Engineer in School and Energy for Brighter Tomorrows Award programmes respectively. Both said taking part in the drama enhanced their understanding of energy issues, raised their awareness about climate change, and encouraged them to embrace low-carbon lifestyles.

Mr Mok Yuen-kwan, who went to see the drama with family members, said, "We are grateful for CLP Power's invitation to the interesting performance where we had chance to learn energy saving tips. We also visited the harbourfront in Tsim Sha Tsui after the show to enjoy the festive atmosphere. It gave us all some wonderful Christmas moments together."
