CLP Fuel Cost Subsidy Programme Application Opens HK\$100 Million to Alleviate Underprivileged Households' Fuel Expenses

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) has set aside HK\$100 million this year for the **CLP Fuel Cost Subsidy Programme** to alleviate the burden on underprivileged households. The programme, which is financed by the **CLP Community Energy Saving Fund**, will provide one-off fuel cost subsidies to 150,000 families in need, including the elderly, low-income families, disabled people, and tenants of subdivided units (SDUs). The Programme will open for application from 30 March.

Soaring international fuel prices has led to sharp rises in the fuel costs for electricity generation over the past two years. To reduce the tariff pressure on underprivileged households, CLP Power has launched the **CLP Fuel Cost Subsidy Programme**, providing one-off fuel cost subsidies of HK\$600 to 100,000 eligible households nominated by non-governmental organisations (NGOs) or community partners. Beneficiaries include single elderly people or elderly couples aged 65 years old or above, low-income families, and people with disabilities. The programme will also distribute one-off fuel cost subsidies to 50,000 tenants of SDUs, each at HK\$800. The total funding for the subsidy programme amounts to HK\$100 million.

CLP Power Managing Director Mr T.K. Chiang said, "As Hong Kong begins its path to recovery after the epidemic, we wish to enhance our support for families in need by providing fuel cost subsidies. The three-month **special fuel rebate** which was announced recently, capping the amount of Fuel Cost Adjustment at 62.8 cents per unit of electricity, helps alleviate customers' financial burden and will give an impetus to economic recovery. International oil prices have shown a stabilising trend and coal prices have fallen. If this trend continues, we believe that our customers will soon see a reduction in the Fuel Cost Adjustment, easing their tariff pressure."

The **CLP Fuel Cost Subsidy Programme** will be open for application from 30 March. Eligible households can apply through NGOs and community partners listed on the programme website at https://e.clp.com.hk/FCSen on the same day (30 March). Details of the programme and eligibility criteria can also be found on the programme website. Applicants can call the programme hotline at 2678 2633 for related enquiries.

CLP Power has made tremendous efforts to implement cost saving initiatives to minimise the magnitude of tariff adjustment in 2023, with the Average Basic Tariff frozen for three consecutive years. To smooth out the impact on our customers, CLP Power drew down the balance of the Tariff Stabilisation Fund to provide a new 2023 Special Energy Saving Rebate of 9.3 cents per unit of electricity. To support the underprivileged families, CLP Power has allocated about HK\$200 million from the CLP Community Energy Saving Fund to roll out a series of community support programmes this year. CLP Fuel Cost Subsidy Programme is one of the key programmes. Other programmes include assistance for tenants of SDUs and families in transitional housing, support for disadvantaged students, and schemes to promote energy conservation, electricity safety and decarbonisation.
