CLP Smart Energy Award Attracts over 700 Entries and Promotes Innovative Energy-Saving Solutions to Achieve Carbon Neutrality

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) today (17 October) hosted a presentation ceremony for the 2023 **Smart Energy Award**, recognising businesses and organisations for their outstanding performance in applying innovative solutions to reduce energy use and improve efficiency. The programme, now in its sixth year, attracted record-high entries from more than 700 corporates and Government bodies, small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs), non-governmental organisations (NGOs), and educational institutions.

Awards were presented in three categories: Carbon Management, Innovation, and Energy Management. Each category comprised a "Corporate and Government bodies" division and a "Catering and SMEs, NGOs, and educational institutions" division. Judges selected a total of 66 winners. (See appendix for full award list.)

Full Nature Farms, which operates a vertical farm in an industrial building, won the **Innovation Excellence Award** in the "Catering and SMEs, NGOs, and educational institutions" division. Vertical farms use space more effectively than traditional farms and produce higher yields of crops for each square metre, but they have higher electricity consumption. The company therefore combined farming technology with artificial intelligence and Internet of Things to optimise the use of LED lights according to the temperature and humidity required by plants at different growth stages. These measures improved the productivity and energy efficiency of the farm and saved more than 150,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity a year, equivalent to a reduction of 59 tonnes of carbon emissions.

Newtech Group won the **Innovation Excellence Award** in the "Corporate and Government bodies" division for introducing an immersion cooling system to address heat dissipation of data centre servers. By submerging servers in non-conductive coolant, the system reduces the use of air-conditioning and significantly lowers the energy consumption of data centres. It also eliminates dust accumulation and enhances the durability of servers. Taking a large data centre as an example, adopting an immersive cooling system can save approximately 44 gigawatt hours (GWh) of

electricity a year compared with traditional air cooling technology, equivalent to a reduction of 17,200 tonnes of carbon emissions.

Catering is a labour-intensive industry with complicated operational processes and a large amount of equipment. Smart technology is a solution to improve the energy efficiency of operations. Fairwood Fast Food Limited (Fairwood) won the **Energy Management Grand Award** in the "Catering and SMEs, NGOs, and educational institutions" division by leveraging the Smart Energy Online platform to monitor real-time energy usage data and analyse energy consumption systematically in more than 100 stores and production plants. The platform enables Fairwood to introduce targeted energy-saving measures, such as switching to more energy efficient kitchen equipment and optimising daily processes to allow employees to adjust their electricity usage patterns. Since switching to the Smart Energy Online platform in January 2022, Fairwood has saved 2 gigawatt hours (GWh) of electricity, equivalent to a reduction of 780 tonnes of carbon emissions.

All of this year's winning business organisations exceeded in energy and low-carbon management, and the implementation of innovative energy-saving solutions, collectively saving around 65 gigawatt hours (GWh) of electricity. On top of promoting innovative energy conservation in the business sector, CLP Power also supports organisations in the area of sustainability-linked loans from financial institutions for investments in energy-saving projects. It has so far helped commercial and industrial customers to obtain more than HK\$2 billion in sustainability-linked loans, accelerating the pace of energy conservation and emission reduction for businesses.

CLP Power Managing Director Mr Joseph Law said, "Hong Kong was hit by a super typhoon and a torrential rainstorm in quick succession, demonstrating how climate change can impact people's livelihoods and lead to economic losses. To combat climate change and support the carbon reduction goals of the country and Hong Kong, CLP Power is committed to helping commercial and industrial customers switch to low-carbon operations."

He added, "The **CLP Smart Energy Award** aims to encourage organisations in different industries to make better use of innovation for energy saving and carbon reduction. We will continue to support customers to improve their energy efficiency and work together with them to promote carbon reduction through sustainable business practices."

The ceremony's officiating guest Under Secretary for Innovation, Technology and Industry Ms Lillian Cheong said, "That the **CLP Smart Energy Award** this year has attracted an unprecedented number of participating organisations demonstrates the

increasing importance the society has attached to energy conservation and emissions reduction by innovation and technology. The HKSAR Government will spare no efforts in building a green technology ecosystem through different measures, with a view to working together with all sectors to make Hong Kong a smart city which is more liveable and sustainable."

The **CLP Smart Energy Award** programme is widely recognised by different sectors and has a judging panel comprising a broad cross-section of officials and experts, including representatives from the Government, business chambers, green groups, and professional bodies.
