CLP Power Teams Up with Community Partners for the Home Electrical Safety Programme to Support the Underprivileged

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) is pleased to announce the allocation of HK\$10 million from its Community Energy Saving Fund to launch the **Home Electrical Safety Programme** (the Programme) again this year. The Programme aims to provide free inspection and maintenance of fixed electrical installations in the homes of elderly people, ethnic minority households, low-income families and people with disabilities, benefitting approximately 2,000 families.

Since the Programme began in 2023, CLP Power has actively collaborated with various community partners to refer people in need to the Programme and facilitate home visits. To extend the reach of the Programme, CLP Power has partnered with community associations and non-profit organisations including Kowloon Federation of Associations, New Territories Association of Societies (NTAS), the Hong Kong CPPCC Youth Association, Caritas Hong Kong, the Christian Family Service Centre, the Salvation Army, the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals and others. Based on each household's specific requirements, CLP Power assigns professional electricians to conduct timely inspections and repairs of fixed electrical installations. This includes replacing aging wiring, light bulbs and their bases, sockets, as well as installing doorbells. Energy saving will also be promoted.

An eighty-year-old lady with serious health issues lives alone in Tsuen Wan in a building that is over 50 years old. Due to deteriorating electrical wiring and a malfunctioning electrical box, power supply to her home was affected recently but she was unable to afford the necessary repairs. Upon learning of her situation, CLP Power immediately arranged electricians to carry out an assessment and rectify her home's electrical issues, swiftly replacing the aging wiring and installations.

CLP Power Chief Corporate Development Officer Ms Quince Chong said, "Caring for the community has always been CLP's core value. We are dedicated to leveraging our power expertise to help those in need. Through strengthening our collaboration with community partners, we hope to broaden the Programme's outreach and extend our support to more people."

Chairman of NTAS Tsuen Wan District Committee Mr Wong Wai-kit said, "Many low-income families often find it difficult to afford the costs of replacing or repairing faulty

fixed electrical installations. This not only causes inconvenience to their daily lives, but may also pose safety risks. NTAS is pleased to partner with CLP Power in promoting the 'Home Electrical Safety Programme' to residents in Tsuen Wan, bringing benefits to more people in need."

About CLP Community Energy Saving Fund

For over 120 years, CLP has grown with the Hong Kong community, adapting to the evolving needs of society and supporting people from all walks of life. Under the current Scheme of Control Agreement, the CLP Community Energy Saving Fund (CESF) is funded by 65% of the incentives earned by CLP from achieving energy saving targets. The CESF has launched various programmes with the aim of supporting the underprivileged, boosting the economy and promoting community-wide decarbonisation.

From 2019 to 2024, the CESF distributed more than HK\$860 million, benefitting about 2.5 million underprivileged families and over 24,000 small and medium enterprises while saving more than 160 gigawatt hours of electricity. In 2025, HK\$240 million is allocated from the CESF to continue launching a range of community support programmes to support the elderly and the underprivileged, promote energy conservation and decarbonisation, and add momentum to Hong Kong's economy. The number of beneficiaries is expected to be more than 900,000.
