# CLP Sponsors 15th National Games, 12th National Games for Persons with Disabilities, 9th National Special Olympic Games (Hong Kong) to Pledge Full Support for Hong Kong Hosting National Mega Sports Event

Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macau will co-host the 15th National Games (NG), the 12th National Games for Persons with Disabilities (NGD), and the 9th National Special Olympic Games (NSOG) in November and December respectively this year. As one of the largest power businesses in Asia Pacific serving Hong Kong for more than 120 years, the CLP Group (CLP) announced today (2 August) that it will fully support and sponsor the Games in Hong Kong, demonstrating its commitment to this national mega event and its support for the HKSAR Government in promoting sports development in both the Greater Bay Area (GBA) and Hong Kong.

To enable more grass-roots families and underprivileged groups to experience the excitement of the events, CLP will sponsor tickets along with goody bags for the needy. This initiative reflects CLP's commitment to community care and promotes community-wide participation in this national sports event. CLP's volunteers will also take part in various roles during the Games to actively contribute to this national sports event.

CLP Holdings Chief Executive Officer Mr T.K. Chiang said, "CLP has grown with the Hong Kong community while supporting its development along the way. We are honoured to demonstrate our support for this national mega sports event. We believe that the 15th NG, the 12th NGD and the 9th NSOG, co-hosted by Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macao for the first time, will further enhance the integrated development among GBA cities, marking a new chapter in sports development for Hong Kong and even the whole GBA."

Today, the "100-day countdown event for the 15th NG, the 12th NGD and the 9th NSOG (Hong Kong)" was organised by the National Games Coordination Office (Hong Kong) at the Hong Kong Velodrome to mark this special occasion.

#### About the 15th NG, the 12th NGD and the 9th NSOG

The National Games (NG), held once every four years, is the nation's highest-level and the largest multi-sports event. The 15th NG and the 12th National Games for Persons with Disabilities (NGD) and the 9th National Special Olympic Games (NSOG) will be cohosted for the first time by Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macao in 2025. Organised by the National Games Coordination Office under the Culture, Sports and Tourism Bureau of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, he 15th NG in

Hong Kong will be held from November 9 (Sunday) to 21 (Friday), 2025. Hong Kong will organise eight competition events, namely, Basketball (men U22), Cycling Track, Fencing, Golf, Handball (men), Rugby Sevens, Triathlon and Beach Volleyball; as well as one mass participation event, Bowling. The 12th NGD and 9th NSOG will be held from December 8 (Monday) to 15 (Monday), 2025. Hong Kong will organise five events including NGD events Boccia, Wheelchair Fencing and Para Table Tennis (TT11), mass participation event Para Dance Sport and NSOG event Table Tennis.
