**CLP Power and Heung Yee Kuk Present
“Together We Power a Brighter New Territories” Exhibition
Electrifying the Past, Powering a Smart Future**

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) is set to celebrate its 125th anniversary in 2026, coinciding with the centenary of Heung Yee Kuk New Territories (Heung Yee Kuk). To commemorate these milestones, CLP Power and Heung Yee Kuk are jointly presenting the “Together We Power a Brighter New Territories” exhibition, which showcases their longstanding partnership in bringing electricity to rural villages, outlying islands and new towns. The exhibition highlights how a stable and reliable electricity supply has driven economic growth and enhanced the quality of life in the New Territories. An opening ceremony was held on 16 September to launch the exhibition.

At the opening ceremony, CLP Power Managing Director Mr Joseph Law said, “Since the 1960s, our Rural Electrification Scheme has powered New Territories’ transformation from rural landscapes to thriving urban centres – an achievement made possible by the steadfast support of Heung Yee Kuk and rural committees. As the Northern Metropolis emerges as Hong Kong’s new growth engine, CLP Power remains committed to powering its development in innovation and technology, industrial and commercial as well as housing. We will ensure a reliable power supply for key projects such as the San Tin Technopole and the data and supercomputing centres at Sandy Ridge, reaffirming our commitment to the HKSAR Government’s development plan.”

Heung Yee Kuk Chairman Mr Kenneth Lau said, “In the 1960s, the late Lord Lawrence Kadoorie frequently visited remote parts of the New Territories to preside over power supply ceremonies. He personally distributed electric appliances such as kettles to villagers, enabling them to experience the benefits of electricity in their own homes for the very first time. Through its pioneering Rural Electrification Scheme, CLP Power brought electricity to more than 250 villages in just three years, transforming rural life and unlocking new opportunities throughout the area. As we look to the future, we will continue our close partnership with CLP Power to drive the smart and sustainable development of the New Territories.”

Other officiating guests at the opening ceremony included Director of Home Affairs Ms Priscilla To, Deputy Director-General of the New Territories Sub-office of Liaison

Office of the Central People's Government Mr Sun Xuewei, Vice Chairmen of the Heung Yee Kuk New Territories Mr Lam Wai-keung and Mr Mok Kam-kwai, Chief Corporate Development Officer of CLP Power Ms Quince Chong and Chief Operating Officer of CLP Power Mr Eric Cheung. Approximately 100 guests comprising District Officers, representatives of District Offices in the New Territories and rural representatives also witnessed the collaboration between CLP Power and Heung Yee Kuk to light up the New Territories.

The exhibition is open to the public free of charge starting September 2025 on the ground floor of Heung Yee Kuk Building at 30 On Muk Street, Shek Mun, Sha Tin. It features three thematic sections: "The Transformation of New Territories Villages", "Honouring the Past, Embracing the Future" and "From Tradition to Smart Living". Through interactive story walls, visitors can discover how electricity has become part of village life and continues to drive the evolution of rural communities toward smarter living. The exhibition also includes valuable historical photographs from as early as the 1930s, vintage electric meters and bills from the 1940s onward, and displays showcasing the longstanding charitable contributions of the Kadoorie family in the New Territories.
