CLP Power Participates in CEPSI to Advance Low Carbon Energy Transition in the Region

The 25th Conference of Electric Power Supply Industry (CEPSI) of the Association of the Electricity Supply Industry of East Asia and the Western Pacific (AESIEAP), was held in Singapore from 29 October to 1 November. CLP Power Managing Director Mr Joseph Law delivered a speech at the opening ceremony in his capacity as Vice President of AESIEAP, encouraging the energy sector to continue innovating and strengthening regional collaboration to jointly drive the energy transition.

During the Conference, representatives from CLP Power presented 13 technical papers covering topics including grid and distributed energy technologies, renewable energy development, intelligent energy management, and digital customer services, showcasing best practices and achievements in energy transition. Among these, the paper, “Grid-scale Hong Kong Battery Energy Storage System to smooth out the demand peak in a green manner”, stood out from nearly 400 papers and is awarded the “Best Paper Award” by the AESIEAP.

To further promote regional energy cooperation, CLP Power will assume the presidency of AESIEAP for the 2026–2027 term and host the AESIEAP CEO Conference in 2026 and the CEPSI 2027 in Hong Kong. Under the theme “Transforming Energy with Intelligence”, the events will bring together industry leaders from different parts of the world to explore topics such as smart systems, sustainable development, and regional collaboration to drive progress in the sector.

CLP Power Managing Director Mr Joseph Law said, “This year marks the 50th anniversary of AESIEAP. As a founding member, CLP Power is deeply honoured to once again assume the leadership role in AESIEAP. Following our hosting of the inaugural and ninth AESIEAP events, we are proud to be the host city again. Hong Kong SAR’s unique role as a “super connector” and “super value-adder” under “One Country, Two Systems” will be fully leveraged through this international platform to deepen regional collaboration. I warmly invite energy professionals to join us in Hong Kong next year to explore how innovation and smart technologies can drive the energy transition and lead us towards a greener, more sustainable future.

AESIEAP is a regional non-governmental organisation founded in 1975 to promote exchanges and cooperation in the Asia-Pacific power industry. Its members are from countries and regions including China, Japan, South Korea, Singapore, the Philippines, Thailand, and Australia etc. As a founding member of AESIEAP, CLP Power maintains close communication and cooperation with power industry partners across the Asia-Pacific region. CEPSI is held biennially and this year's conference attracted over 3,000 participants from energy organisations, Government departments, power companies, and research institutes from the region and around the world.
