CLP Power Launches Hong Kong's First Electric Appliance Library at Yuen Long Light Public Housing

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) has launched Hong Kong's first-ever Electric Appliance Library at the Yau Pok Road Light Public Housing in Yuen Long. The initiative offers over one hundred energy-efficient household electrical appliances for residents to borrow free of charge, promoting low-carbon living and the concept of community resource sharing. CLP Power is engaging with operators of other Light Public Housing projects to explore expanding this innovative idea to benefit more households.

The Electric Appliance Library at Yau Pok Road Light Public Housing in Yuen Long was officially launched in mid-September, with the opening ceremony officiated by Secretary for Housing Ms Winne Ho. The library provides 125 household electrical appliances, including cordless cyclone vacuum cleaners, upright garment steamers, inverter intelligent steam microwave ovens and oscillating ceramic heaters. Residents can borrow large electrical appliances from the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals (TWGHs) Service Point within the estate, while small electrical appliances can be borrowed at any time via self-service smart lockers.

Secretary for Housing Ms Winne Ho said, "The Electric Appliance Library integrates the concepts of environmental protection, sharing and social care. The electrical appliances are well-suited to the needs of Light Public Housing households, promoting community resource sharing and mutual assistance in the neighbourhood. This initiative fully demonstrates collaboration between businesses and communities in responding to social needs through innovative approaches. I hope the Electric Appliance Library can be extended to other Light Public Housing projects and encourage more socially responsible enterprises to participate in building a caring and sustainable community."

CLP Power Managing Director Mr Joseph Law said that the company has long been committed to caring for the community through various initiatives. He added, "The Electric Appliance Library at Yau Pok Road in Yuen Long serves as a great starting point. As CLP Power approaches its 125th anniversary next year, we hope that the 125 energy-efficient electrical appliances in the library will encourage households in the Light Public Housing to embrace a greener and low-carbon lifestyle, while also enhancing

convenience and happiness in their daily lives.” He also expressed gratitude to TWGHs and Midea for their full support of the Electric Appliance Library.

TWGHs 4th Vice-Chairman Mr Jason Lee said, “As the operator of the Light Public Housing at Yau Pok Road in Yuen Long, TWGHs is committed to planning suitable services for residents. CLP Power’s Electric Appliance Library is a meaningful initiative that allows residents to borrow a variety of energy-efficient household electrical appliances for free, helping to foster a warm and comfortable small community.”

Resident Mr Lam, was the first to experience the Electric Appliance Library by trialling the electric oven. He shared that he enjoys cooking for his family but had limited space at home to accommodate additional cooking appliances, which restricted his cooking options. He added, “Now we can borrow electrical appliances from the library for free, which is very convenient. This electric oven is lightweight and easy to use. It makes bean curd rolls crispier than pan-frying them, and my family loves them.”

To enhance residents’ awareness of electrical safety, CLP Power, in collaboration with the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department and Midea, hosted a seminar to share practical knowledge on home electrical safety and energy efficiency labelling, while demonstrating proper usage of household electrical appliances.
