## **CLP Power Hosts All-Electric Cooking Competition cum Poon Choi Feast Promoting Low-Carbon Living and Sharing Warmth with Light Public Housing Families**

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) organised an all-electric cooking competition with Tung Wah Group of Hospitals (TWGHs) for residents of Hong Kong's first Light Public Housing project – Yuen Long Yau Pok Road Light Public Housing – and arranged a festive poon choi banquet as an early celebration of the Lunar New Year in a green manner.

In September last year, CLP Power partnered with TWGHs to launch Hong Kong's first Electric Appliance Library at the Yuen Long Yau Pok Road Light Public Housing. The initiative allows residents to borrow energy-efficient household appliances free of charge, encouraging a low-carbon lifestyle. To further promote all-electric cooking among residents, CLP Power and TWGHs co-organised an all-electric cooking competition, offering residents the opportunity to share their cooking experiences. The competition attracted participation from more than 30 families. Six finalists competed on 31 January, using energy-efficient electric appliances to turn fresh, locally produced ingredients into delicious low-carbon dishes that impressed the judging panel. On the competition day, around 200 residents were also treated to a poon choi banquet, fostering a warm and festive atmosphere.

Officiating guest and competition judge, Secretary for Housing Ms Winnie Ho, said, "The Yuen Long Yau Pok Road project is the first Light Public Housing initiative launched by the Government, providing 2,100 units. We are pleased to see the significant improvement in the residents' living conditions. At today's All-Electric Cooking Competition, I have the pleasure of tasting six dishes thoughtfully prepared by residents. Each dish is creative, nutritious, and filled with the comforting flavours of home. Together with enjoying a poon choi banquet with the residents, the experience fills me with the strong neighbourhood spirit here, as well as warmth and happiness."

CLP Power Managing Director Mr Joseph Law said, "CLP Power is committed to caring for the community, working proactively with different community partners to support those in need. Through the all-electric cooking competition and the Electric Appliance Library,
