**CLPe Supports Budget Measures to Advance Green Shipping and
Promote the Use of Electric Vehicles
Accelerating Hong Kong's Low-Carbon Transformation**

CLPe supports the measures announced in the 2026-27 Budget of the Hong Kong SAR Government, which aim to promote the use of electric vehicles and green shipping, further accelerating the high-quality development of Hong Kong's economy.

The Company welcomes the Budget's announcement to waive the first registration tax for electric commercial vehicles until end- March 2028. This incentive will drive the electrification of commercial vehicles and advance Hong Kong's transition to green transportation. CLPe fully supports the Government's initiative by expanding the charging network with fast chargers as the backbone, and by increasing the number of charging facilities compatible with both GB/T (China standard) and CCS2 (European standard). CLPe aims to increase the total number of charging bays to around 1,500 over the next two years to meet the operational needs of electric commercial vehicles and fleets and to underpin the Government's plan to introduce more competitively priced electric commercial vehicle models.

CLPe also fully supports the Budget's announcement of port dues concessions for vessels powered by green fuel and those carrying green fuels, as well as incentives for green vessels registered in Hong Kong and a legislative amendment exercise to provide more anchorages for green maritime fuel bunkering operations. CLPe anticipates these initiatives to encourage more vessels to bunker green fuels in Hong Kong, accelerating the shipping industry's green transformation. The company will continue to deliver professional liquefied natural gas (LNG) bunkering services, contributing to Hong Kong's development into a green maritime fuel bunkering centre and reinforcing its position as an international maritime hub.
