CLP Celebrates 125th Anniversary***Launches community initiatives to support families in need
Reaffirms steadfast commitment to Hong Kong***

The CLP Group (CLP) today marked its 125th anniversary with a cocktail reception at its Kai Tak headquarters, reaffirming its longstanding commitment to delivering world-class, reliable and sustainable electricity services for Hong Kong. To commemorate the milestone, CLP also announced two community initiatives aimed at supporting the underprivileged and strengthening the local economy.

Hosted by CLP Holdings Chairman the Honourable Sir Michael Kadoorie, the event was officiated by Acting Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) the Honourable Chan Kwok-ki. Other distinguished guests included Deputy Commissioner of the Office of the Commissioner of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China in the HKSAR Mr Li Yongsheng, Secretary for Environment and Ecology of the HKSAR the Honourable Tse Chin-wan, Deputy Director-General of the Department of Economic Affairs of the Liaison Office of the Central People's Government in the HKSAR Mr Guo Shaowei and more than 150 business and community leaders.

CLP Holdings Chairman the Honourable Sir Michael Kadoorie said, "Since 1901, CLP has grown hand-in-hand with Hong Kong, helping to power its transformation into a leading international financial centre. Throughout this journey, we have delivered world-class supply reliability, safeguarded the city's energy security and supported its long-term development. Our city's unique strengths – its stable business environment, robust rule of law and policies that foster long-term investment – have been fundamental to our growth. As the city advances major initiatives such as the Northern Metropolis, CLP will continue to uphold the commitment and confidence that have guided us for more than 125 years, providing reliable and sustainable energy to power Hong Kong's continued progress."

Chief Executive of the HKSAR the Honourable John KC Lee delivered a pre-recorded congratulatory speech. He said, "My warmest congratulations to everyone at CLP on this remarkable anniversary. Since its earliest days, CLP has been a key partner in building the energy infrastructure that supports our daily lives and drives our economic vitality. Today, as we build on our status as an international financial, shipping and trade centre, and as an international aviation hub – while developing into new roles, including that of an innovation and technology hub – CLP continues to play a vital role in powering our progress. This solid foundation prepares us for tomorrow's

priorities, including the Northern Metropolis. I look forward to our continued work together in building a better, greener, and even more vibrant Hong Kong.”

In Hong Kong, CLP operates across the entire electricity value chain – from generation to transmission, distribution and retail – delivering world-class supply reliability of 99.999% to more than 80% of the city’s population. To support the HKSAR Government’s target of achieving carbon neutrality before 2050 and the nation’s “dual-carbon” goals, CLP has stepped up its energy transition through measures such as decarbonising power generation, advancing electrification and helping customers improve energy efficiency. As the HKSAR Government develops its first five-year development plan, CLP will actively participate in the formulation of the plan, leveraging its power expertise to support Hong Kong in aligning with the national strategies and capturing emerging opportunities. CLP will also continue to showcase Hong Kong’s success stories under “One Country, Two Systems” to the international community and contribute to the advancement of Chinese modernisation.

In keeping with the Kadoorie family’s long-lasting tradition of community care, CLP is marking its 125th anniversary with two initiatives to give back to society.

The first initiative is the **CLP Retail and Catering Coupons Programme**. Supported by HK\$60 million from the CLP Community Energy Saving Fund, CLP will distribute consumption coupons worth HK\$100 to around 600,000 eligible households in its supply area. Now in its fifth edition, the programme aims to stimulate consumer spending, boost the economy and support the underprivileged. Starting tomorrow (27 March), beneficiaries can use the coupons at over 4,000 participating retail and catering outlets.

The second initiative, the **125 Cheers Programme**, is organised in collaboration with local community groups and non-governmental organisations. From June to November, CLP will partner with the New Territories Association of Societies, Kowloon Federation of Associations, Tung Wah Group of Hospitals, Po Leung Kuk, Pok Oi Hospital, Yan Chai Hospital, The Lok Sin Tong Benevolent Society, Kowloon and Yan Oi Tong to host lunch gatherings for 2,000 elderly residents living in its supply area. Supported by CLP Volunteers, the programme will help participants reconnect with their communities and share meaningful moments.
