**CLP and DNMC Jointly Organise Hong Kong's First
National Security Education Day – Nuclear Security Event
Promoting Nuclear Security Education
Deepening Youth Awareness of National Security**

Nuclear security is one of the major fields under the holistic approach to national security. In support of the National Security Education Day and the first-ever nationwide nuclear security-themed activities launched in the Guangdong–Hong Kong–Macao Greater Bay Area, CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) and Daya Bay Nuclear Power Operations and Management Co., Ltd. (DNMC) jointly organised the “National Security Education Day – Nuclear Security” event on 8 April at City University of Hong Kong (CityU). Through a series of activities, including nuclear security exhibition, seminar, and interactive exchanges with students, the event aimed to enhance public understanding of nuclear energy and nuclear security, particularly among the younger generation.

During the event, Guangdong Nuclear Power Stations Nuclear Safety Consultative Committee (NSCC) Vice-Chairman Professor Daniel Cheng and CityU Department of Mechanical Engineering Assistant Professor Ma Kan hosted a nuclear security seminar for around 60 students from CityU. The two speakers shared the scientific knowledge of nuclear energy and their valuable experience in promoting nuclear safety. They also highlighted the important role of nuclear energy in ensuring a reliable and stable electricity supply for Hong Kong, as well as its contribution to supporting the city to achieve its carbon neutrality goal. The guests and students also visited the CLP Power Low Carbon Energy Education Centre and the nuclear security exhibition specially launched for the event.

The nuclear security exhibition features a range of interactive installations and themed display, introducing the principles of nuclear power generation, the safe operation of nuclear power plants, national nuclear energy development, and the advanced nuclear fusion technology. The exhibition is located on the 3/F of the Lau Ming Wai Academic Building at CityU. It will be open to the public for three weeks from 8 April to 30 April.

CLP Holdings Senior Director – Nuclear Mr Eddie Wu said, “CLP Power is committed to providing Hong Kong with safe, reliable, non-carbon and stable electricity, and supporting the city’s energy security and long-term development with our power expertise. As early as 1985, CLP partnered with China General Nuclear Power Corporation (CGN) to build the Daya Bay Nuclear Power Station, the first large-scale commercial nuclear power station in the Chinese Mainland. Since 1994, we have pioneered the import of nuclear energy from Daya Bay to Hong Kong through a dedicated plant and dedicated line. Today, nuclear energy meets about a quarter of Hong Kong’s electricity demand and has become an integral part of the city’s power supply. We are pleased to collaborate with DNMC in organising nuclear security activities in Hong Kong and promoting of public education on nuclear security.”

On 10 April, CLP Power will participate in the National Security Education Day – Nuclear Security flagship event organised by CGN under the guidance of the Ministry of Ecology and Environment in Shenzhen. Together with the Guangdong Provincial Government, the Macao SAR Government, CGN and representatives from the industry, CLP Power will strive to deepen exchanges and cooperation on nuclear energy between Guangdong and Hong Kong, and between Guangdong and Macao, jointly promoting regional nuclear safety.
