Legislative Council Members Visit CLP Power Ho To West Substation to Understand Power Supply Planning to Fully Support the Northern Metropolis Development

The President of Legislative Council (LegCo) Dr Hon Starry Lee, members of Panel on Commerce, Industry, Innovation and Technology, and other LegCo Members visited the Northern Metropolis yesterday (9 April) to gain a better understanding of the development of the Hong Kong Park of the Hetao Shenzhen-Hong Kong Science and Technology Innovation Co-operation Zone. Accompanied by the Secretary for Innovation, Technology and Industry, Professor Sun Dong, and the Permanent Secretary for Innovation, Technology and Industry and Chairperson of the Hong Kong-Shenzhen Innovation and Technology Park Limited (HSITP), Mr Kevin Choi, the LegCo Members toured Ho To West Substation of CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) to learn about how CLP Power has adopted forward-looking planning to strengthen the overall power supply network in the area, in full support of the future development of the Northern Metropolis.

Ho To West Substation is the first building completed in the HSITP, providing electricity supply to the Loop and the HSITP. CLP Power Chief Corporate Development Officer Ms Quince Chong, and Senior Director – Power Systems Mr Sam Law, briefed the LegCo Members on CLP Power's forward planning in the area over the years and its continued investments in power infrastructure.

CLP Power has been providing reliable electricity supply to the Northern Metropolis. As early as 2021, before the HKSAR Government announced the Northern Metropolis Development Strategy, CLP Power had already constructed more than 20 substations in the area. Since 2024, three new substations came into operation, supplying electricity to the Lok Ma Chau Loop including the HSITP, Kwu Tung North, Ma Tso Lung New Development Area, and Fanling North New Development Area, further strengthening and expanding the backbone of the power grid in the area. In addition, CLP Power's overall power supply planning has already taken into account the Government's recently announced Sandy Ridge Data Facility Cluster development project. CLP Power will maintain close communication with customers to understand their electricity needs at different stages of development and provide timely, appropriate and flexible power supply solutions.

The LegCo Members also noted that the new power supply network for the Northern Metropolis will utilise underground cables to minimise the impact of external

environmental factors such as inclement weather, thereby further enhancing supply reliability. As the innovation and technology industries in the Northern Metropolis advance at full pace, CLP Power has both the capability and confidence to deliver the necessary grid expansion projects in line with the development pace of the Northern Metropolis. CLP Power will also proactively and closely coordinate with relevant government bureaux and departments to deliver full support to the future development of the Northern Metropolis and Hong Kong’s innovation and technology sector. Through these concerted efforts, CLP Power will continue to strengthen grid resilience and provide a safe, stable and reliable electricity supply.
