## **CLP and Tsinghua University Launch Inaugural Summer Internship Programme Nurturing New Generation of Energy Talent**

CLP Holdings Limited (CLP) today (29 June) announced the launch of its inaugural summer internship programme in collaboration with Tsinghua University. Nine undergraduate students from Tsinghua University's Department of Electrical Engineering will undertake a four-week internship at CLP, ending on 24 July. The programme builds on the longstanding partnership between CLP and the University, underscoring a shared commitment to nurturing energy professionals with technical knowledge and practical experience needed to support the country's energy transition.

The programme marks the formal start of teaching and practical training collaboration between CLP and Tsinghua University, following CLP's designation last year as the University's first "Undergraduate Practice Teaching Base" in Hong Kong. It also represents an important step forward in the two parties' joint talent development efforts.

Hong Kong's highly reliable power infrastructure, international business environment and well-established expertise in energy system management provide a unique platform for students to understand how energy companies maintain supply reliability while advancing decarbonisation and innovation in customer services in a highly urbanised environment.

Through CLP's vertically integrated electricity supply business, the students will gain exposure across the industry value chain, including generation, transmission and distribution, customer services and low-carbon energy. Under the guidance of CLP mentors, they will take part in projects covering transmission and distribution, smart grids and renewable energy, applying their academic knowledge in practical settings. The programme will also feature a series of activities to enhance students' understanding of energy policies in Hong Kong.

CLP and Tsinghua University share a longstanding partnership since 2009, when CLP contributed HK\$6 million to establish the "Tsinghua—CLP Education Fund" in support of the Department of Electrical Engineering through scholarships, research grants and applied learning initiatives. Around 500 outstanding undergraduates and postgraduates have benefitted to date.

The internship programme is one of the key outcomes of the strategic cooperation agreement signed last June. Under the agreement, CLP became Tsinghua University's first "Undergraduate Practice Training Base" in Hong Kong and will host

undergraduate students from Tsinghua University's Department of Electrical Engineering for internships each summer.

CLP Power Chief Corporate Development Officer Ms Quince Chong said, "This year marks CLP's 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary. For more than a century, CLP has been part of Hong Kong's story, providing safe and reliable electricity underpinning the city's progress. In this milestone year, we are especially pleased to welcome the first cohort of Tsinghua students to CLP, offering them first-hand insights into Hong Kong's energy sector and CLP's practical experience in operations, energy transition and innovation. The programme exemplifies Hong Kong's role as a 'super connector', enabling young talent to broaden their horizons through exposure to global energy industry practices. As the energy transition accelerates, the need for high-calibre energy professionals is becoming ever more pressing. CLP looks forward to working with Tsinghua University to nurture a new generation of energy professionals with a strong technical grounding, a global outlook, digital capabilities and an innovative mindset, contributing to the country's energy development and dual carbon goals."
