Support for People Living in Sub-Divided Units

CLP Power provides support for people living in sub-divided units (SDUs) through the Power Connect programme. In 2020, CLP Power will allocate HK\$7 million to help SDU tenants who do not benefit from the Government's electricity charges subsidy schemes. The programme allows SDU tenants to reduce their electricity expenses and improve their home safety and living environment.

1. Electricity Subsidies

- CLP Power will provide electricity subsidies to 10,000 SDU tenants nominated by non-Governmental organisations (NGOs). The subsidy given to each successful applicant will increase from HK\$500 in 2019 to HK\$600 in 2020.

2. Rewiring Work

- CLP Power will subsidise landlords of SDUs nominated by NGOs for the rewiring work needed for the installation of individual electricity meters. Where building management give consent, registered electrical contractors appointed by CLP Power will handle the rewiring work, the inspection of devices, and the issuing of completion certificates for meter installation by CLP Power.

Assistance for Transitional Housing Residents

CLP Power will make available HK\$10 million over a three-year period from 2020 to provide energy-efficient electrical appliances for 10,000 transitional housing units to help residents to reduce their electricity consumption and costs. Of this, HK\$2 million will be used in 2020 to benefit an estimated 2,000 households.
