CLP Power Extends Free Charging Service to Encourage Green Motoring

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited ("CLP Power") has for years promoted low-carbon driving by providing an expanding electric vehicle (EV) charging service to make Hong Kong a greener and smarter city. Today (5 November), CLP Power announced the free service at its charging stations will be extended until the end of 2020, continuing to offer EV drivers a convenient and reliable territory-wide network.

In response to the demand for EV charging service, CLP Power has already established 54 semi-quick and quick EV charging stations with a total of 161 chargers in Kowloon, the New Territories, and Lantau.

EV drivers can download the CLP mobile app or check the CLP Power website for the location of EV charging stations and to receive the latest updates on the service.

CLP Power will conduct regular reviews on the use and arrangements of its EV charging network to keep pace with evolving market needs.
